STICK AND FLICK!



- To avoid unsightly dog waste bags being left behind, and the need for their disposal, please use a stick to remove deposits from the path.
- Just “flick” it into the undergrowth where it can break down naturally.

RING OF TREES

- The Ring of Trees is a circular walk through many of the woodlands which surround Buxton.
- It can be completed as a 10 mile (16km) walk, or taken in three shorter sections so you (and your dog, of course) can take your time and explore each of the woods.
